After completion of day two, workshop participants will be able to:

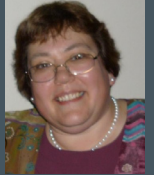
- Discuss the layout of the courtroom

Tim was admitted to practise as a barrister and solicitor in 1978 after completing degrees in economics and law and obtaining a Diploma of Education at Monash University.

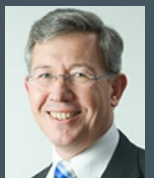
